



## CVI 2023 Challenging Case Competition Submission Instructions

Please submit your most challenging, innovative or educational case. Cases will be reviewed by the course directors and the best cases in each category will compete as semi-finalists during dedicated sessions at CVI 2023. The top cases in each category will be asked to participate as finalists on Saturday, July 22. The top case in each category will receive a \$1,000 prize.

Semi-finalists are eligible to receive a travel grant that would include airfare, complimentary registration and hotel.

**Due Date:** May 1, 2023

**Categories:** Submit your case in one of the three categories: Coronary, Structural or Peripheral.

### Submission Format:

- Submit via PowerPoint, using the following naming convention:  
Last Name\_Submission Category\_Case Title  
(example: Smith\_Peripheral\_PE Management)
- On first slide, include the following: Case Title, Submitter First and Last name, Degree, Affiliation, Contact email address
- Indicate your submission category
- File size must be no more than 250MB in size

### Submission Guidelines:

- Please describe the salient features of the case and the lessons learned
- Videos are acceptable and preferred (but keep the file size limit in mind)
- There is no limit in the number of slides

**Next Steps:** If selected, you will be invited to participate during CVI as a semi-finalist on July 20-21 and receive further instructions.
